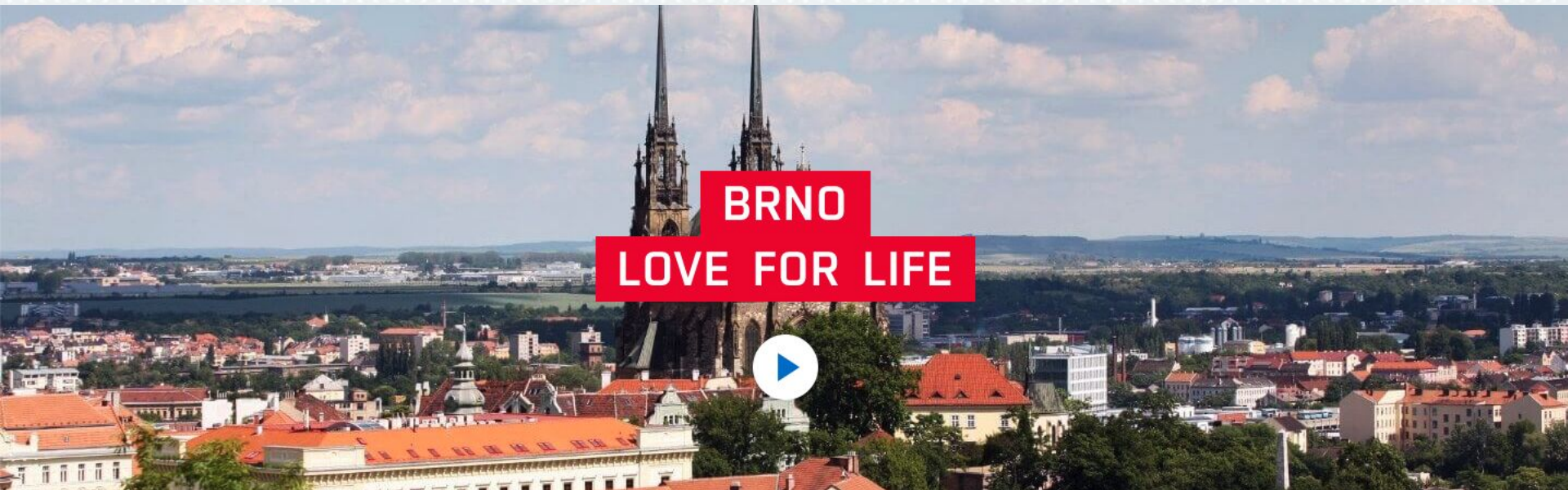

- Though listed not all courses may be actually available, check it with a coordinator.

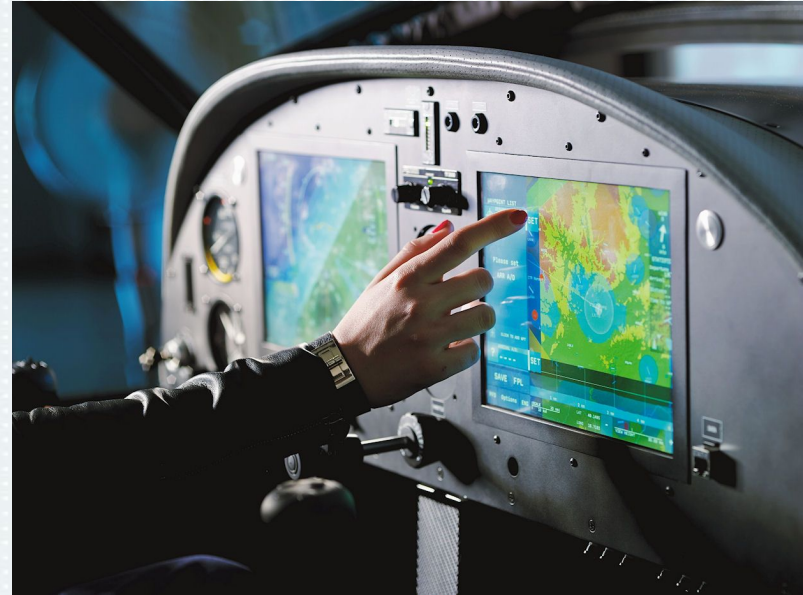

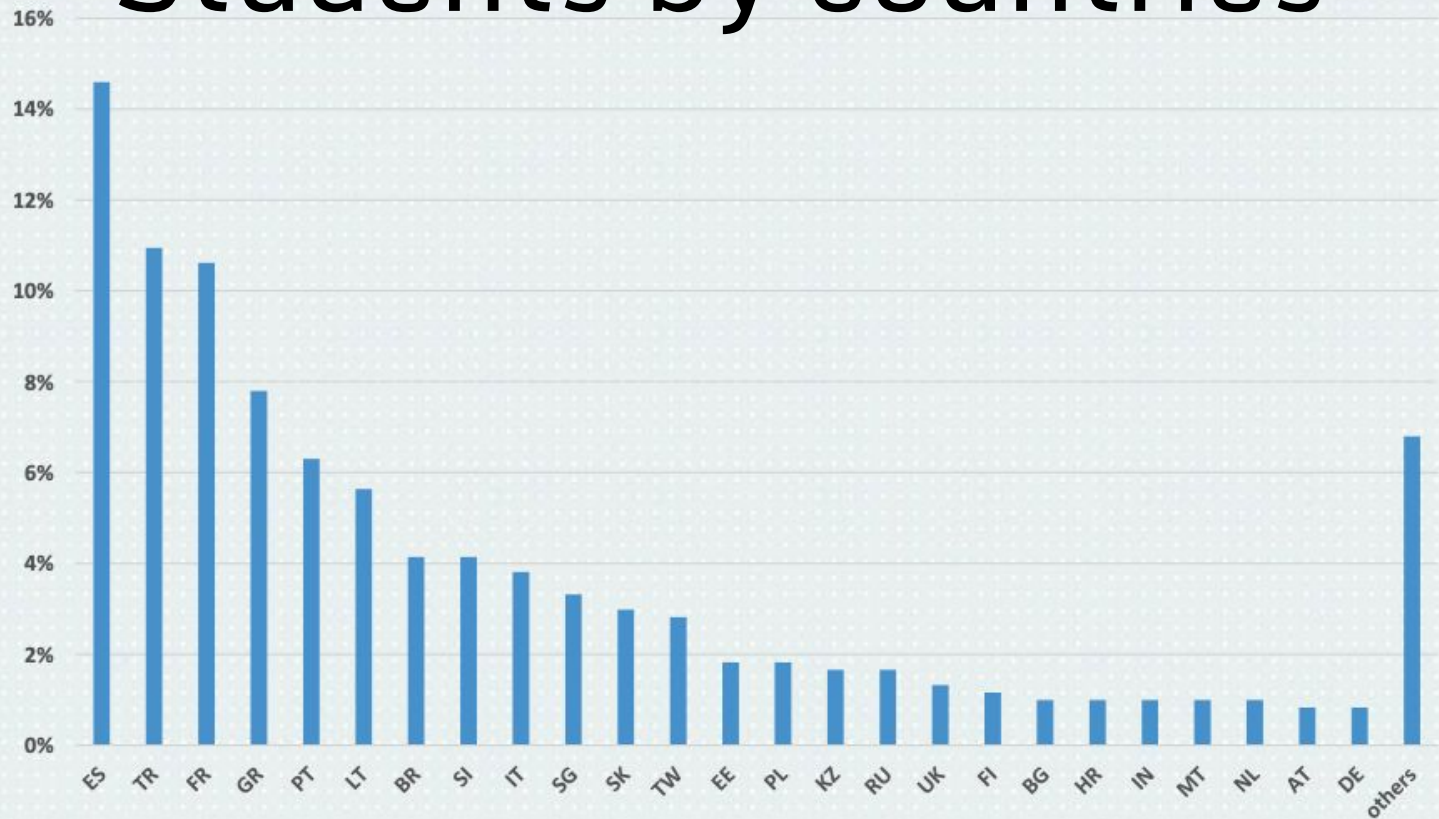
