Exchange programs

Students are eligible to apply for one or two semesters in all undergraduate programs offered by UNESP. Foreign students must know Portuguese or Spanish to participate in the regular exchange programs.

Lab Internships

Students can apply for research internships of 1 to 3 months according to their demand. Once there, they can work on challenging projects and be mentored in English by UNESP's top researchers. To do that, foreign students must contact our Incoming Officer at **incoming@unesp.br** informing their areas of interest and period for the internship so that we can check the availability.








UNESP Research Areas: 2014-2019
