Living expenses

Credit and debit cards are the primary means of payment in Finland. Some establishments do not even accept cash as payment. For basic expenses such as food, rent and transportation, you should count at least $700-1000 \in$ for each month. This could be divided, for example, as follows:

Rent : 400-700 € Food : 250 € Transport: 25-80 € Leisure: 100 €
