About the university

The Carpathian State College in Krosno (until 2020 «Stanisław Pigoń State Higher Vocational School in Krosno») was established on the basis of the Regulation of the Council of Ministers of June 15, 1999 (Journal of Laws No. 55, item 575).

By the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 23 March 2020 (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 533), the State Higher Vocational School in Stanisława Pigionia in Krosno changed its name to the Carpathian State University in Krosno. Over the years, the university has expanded its teaching base. Thanks to its own funds and EU funds, it was possible to build four beautiful campuses located in different parts of Krosno.

The Carpathian State College in Krosno in Krosno becomes even more beautiful every year, its teaching potential increases, and the brand developed over many years is well recognized in the region. It is the first university in Krosno, but it proudly refers to the rich history of education in our city at the secondary or semi-senior level of teaching staff for nearby schools.

About the quality of education at KPU

The quality of education directly depends on the level of education and working conditions of the teaching staff. The teaching staff at KPU in Krosno conducts scientific research, cooperating, among others, with universities in Poland and abroad, as well as with local institutions.

Improvement of study programs in the fields of study at KPU takes place through:

Mechanical Engineering

Studies in the field of Mechanics and Machine Construction were based on the analysis of the requirements in terms of knowledge and professional competences for a modern mechanical engineer, including in the context of the implementation of Industry 4.0. Graduates are prepared to solve technical problems in the field of construction, construction and operation of machines and devices. The studies last 7 semesters and end with awarding the title of engineer. Their knowledge in the field of construction and operation of machines is also enriched with knowledge in the field of electrical engineering and electronics, so that they are able to design and operate mechatronic and diagnostic systems.



Informatics Engineering

You will learn the principles of operation of modern computers and devices cooperating with them. You will gain specialist knowledge in the field of programming and administration of information systems, databases and Internet technology. You can choose one of the specializations (chosen during your studies):

- security of information systems
- network information systems
- internet technologies and databases



Power engineering

Graduates of the Faculty of Power Engineering, after successfully completing seven-semester first-cycle studies, obtain the professional title of engineer. This title confirms the mastery of basic technical knowledge in the field of broadly understood energy issues. The acquired knowledge during the studies is a prerequisite for starting your own activity, mainly in the field of eco-energy (heat pumps, solar collectors and modules, home wind farms, hydrogen technology, construction of geothermal sediments). In the field of bioenergy production, by fermentation of organic substances, biogas or the production of biofuels.



Living Costs

Monthly expenses (average value)

- Rent in a shared flat (or dormitory)/person: 100-300 E
