CHEMICAL ENGINEERING AWARD BEng (Hons)

The course combines academic study, hands-on experience and group projects to ensure you develop the essential practical and communication abilities required by employers in 21st century process industries.

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING AWARD BEng (Hons)

The MEng (Hons) / BEng (Hons) Mechanical Engineering degrees focus on industry-relevant topics to reflect the needs of today's employers, giving you the opportunity to build a successful career in the design, engineering and manufacturing sectors.

You will gain knowledge of scientific and engineering principles and take a flexible approach towards new ideas and developments. You will hone your practical skills by using our industry-standard equipment, making you attractive to prospective employers and enabling you to work effectively as part of a team.



How to apply

UWS'S ERASMUS+

UWS is an active partner in the EU funded Erasmus+ which gives you the chance to spend time with one of our European partner universities, where you can follow modules related to your UWS course.

CIVIL ENGINEERING (GRADUATE APPRENTICESHIP) AWARD BEng (Hons)

The course uses modern blended learning, industry-led projects, and minimal exam based assessments. It focuses on cultivating professional development skills in project management, enquiry based research, and problem based learning. During your time in UWS you will be supported by a dedicated team of lecturers, you will be assigned a dedicated personal tutor and workplace mentor.



COMPUTER-AIDED DESIGN (3RD YEAR ENTRY) AWARD BSc (Hons)

The BSc Computer-Aided Design will put your creative and technical skills to the test to produce digital models (2D and 3D designs) and specifications for a range of product development projects.

Increasing pressure on manufacturing organisations to be more productive, efficient and pro-active to market needs has forced manufacturers to adopt new, faster and functionally advanced design, manufacturing and communication tools to maintain a competitive advantage.

The course has been developed to meet the needs of industry to enhance your existing qualifications in design or a related area.
