Full time course load per semester	<p>Licence 1 – 2 - 3 (Undergraduate) : 60 ECTS/YEAR 1 ECTS = 20 hours works (lecture, Pratical/Tutorial Class, personal work)</p>
Free Support Teaching in French, for exchange Students	<p>The UGA organizes and pays 2 sessions of French classes each year, one from September to December and one from January to April (a total of 20 hours per session, 2 hours a week). Each student is asked to take a mandatory test in French in order to form groups based on proficiency level. Further information will be provided after your registration.</p>

French Language requirements for Erasmus students	<p>European council level B1 or B2. This minimum level is required for the students to be able to follow the courses taught in French. Certification by French teacher at home university or by Alliance Française can be useful. At the IUT all courses are taught in French, except in the International Class where all courses are in English.</p>

Student Housing	<p><u>If you are an exchange student:</u> A few days after your acceptance at the IUT, you will receive an e-mail, initiated by the Housing Service of the “International Students and Scholars Office” (ISSO), that informs you of the possibility to fill in the housing application form online (with your personal login and password). So don’t forget to send us the Application Forms as soon as possible and imperatively before the IUT application deadlines.</p> <p><u>If you a non-exchange student:</u> You have to follow a “D.S.E.” Procedure: www.crous-grenoble.fr/demanderunlogement/logement-etudiant-international/</p>

Health Insurance	<p>French National Health Insurance is mandatory (the “Sécurité Sociale”). Whatever your nationality, registration at the Student Social Security Coverage is required (cost: about 215 €, to pay at the time of registration).</p> <p><u>Except in the following cases:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students with European nationality will have to present their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) which covers the entire period of their stay. Refund claims are to be addressed to the “Service International de la Caisse Primaire d’Assurance Maladie” (CPAM).

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students from Quebec will have to present their RAMQ form n° SE-401-Q-106 (for academic programmes) or Q-104 (for an internship). - Students staying less than 90 days are not considered residents, and do not need to enroll. - Students 28 years of age or older cannot enroll in the French Social Security, they will need to be covered either by an adequate insurance in their home country or by a private insurance in France. <p>Please note: emergency medical evacuation is not covered by the “Sécurité Sociale”. Students are strongly encouraged to verify that their home insurance covers this eventuality.</p>
